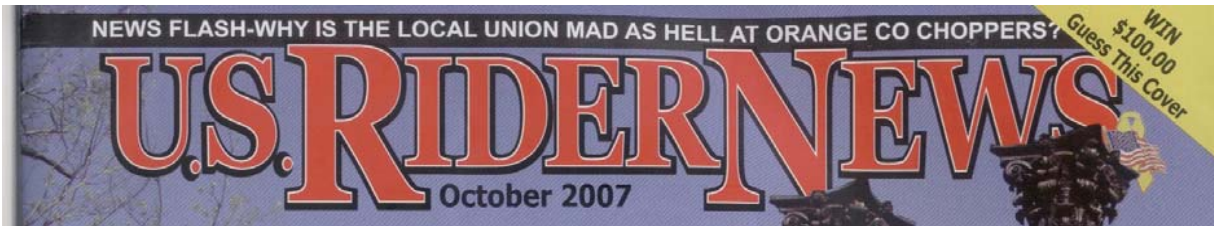

Hugger Gloves now sells the perfect solution for those soggy leather gloves that require days to dry out and leave you wondering why you spent your hard earned cash for such an inferior product. Hugger Gloves' Technaline process completely waterproofs their leather gloves. No longer do you have to worry about those sudden showers or torrential downpours because your hands will stay as dry as the rest of your body (in a rain suit) due to the impregnation of the leather with Technaline.

Hugger Gloves leather will not soak up rain or any other water. Go ahead, reach into the cooler.

Most manufacturers only claim to have water repellent products. Hugger products are not only waterproof leather but they are superior in quality and style to other gloves due to the diligent attention to detail and personal attention at every level.

Hugger Gloves has a number of styles and use specific products from gauntlet, full finger, and fingerless to stylish driving gloves and vented mesh summer gloves.
